Dr. Evans cooperates with Asia Strategy on all of the firm's energy related research. He specializes in international political economy, energy market liberalization, and international trade. He is a Senior Associate at Cambridge Energy Research Associates and a Postdoctoral Associate at MIT Laboratory for Energy and Environment and lecturer for a course on the increasing number of mega-energy projects being developed in North East Asia and elsewhere around the world. He has also served as a consultant to a broad range of private firms and government organizations including American Superconductor Corp., US-ASEAN Council, the US Trade Promotion Coordinating Committee, US Department of Energy, the World Bank and the Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD).
